The SNAP mobile spay-neuter clinic will provide this service to **QUALIFYING LOW INCOME** individuals. Residents from the Cedar Grove Mobile Home Community will be served first. Proof low income is required. Clients and their place in line will be determined by lottery as early as 6:30 am when the advance team arrives. Please visit our website for more details.

Operation Paperback Huge Success

The response of the community to Pet Hub Animal Rescue's Operation Paperback program was overwhelming. The community donated approximately 1,500 books to the initiative and more than 60 shipments were sent to fulfill requests from our troops.

The troops clearly appreciated the support. In the words of one soldier in Kabul who received books from Operation Paperback, "on behalf of the whole multinational team [in] Kabul, we just wanted to pass on our thanks for the kind donation of novels by Volunteers of Operation Paperback. It's difficult to explain/underestimate that little spark of interest/excitement when you come across a new or old, familiar novel to read. As you can appreciate.

Given the overwhelming response to Operation Paperback, Pet Hub plans to repeat this event for the community each January. The program will be expanded next year to include a "Sponsor a Box" alternative which will allow residents who do not have books to donate to make donations that defray the postage cost of shipping the books to our troops.



Pet Hub's Re-Home Program

Pet Hub understands the heart-wrenching decision that is associated with having to give up a loving pet. Circumstances beyond a person's control occur where they are unable to continue caring for a four-legged family member. To provide an alternative to residents, Pet Hub has initiated a re-home program.

Pet Hub is willing to assist you in the process of "re-homing" your pet via our adoption program. Since we rely on a foster system, owners will provide a loving home until your pet's adoption. Pets must be healthy and up-to-date on their vaccinations. Pet Hub may assist owners in vetting their pets on a case-by-case basis. You will be eligible to participate in our mobile adoptions. Photos and a biography about your pet will be posted on our website, and if available spotlighted at local businesses to increase your pet's exposure to the community to help your pet get adopted as soon as possible.

On average, it takes approximately 3 months to re-home your pet. If you have any questions or concerns about the process of "re-homing" your pet please contact Pet Hub.

"It's time to go see Teacher," states a client of Pearland Barkway. With a quick jump and a wagging tail, another critter is dropped off for doggy daycare. Pearland Barkway is a retreat for your animal, a place to mingle and play. "We want our dogs to be happy while they are here, happy to come back and tired when they go home," boasts Susan McCormack.

The driving force behind Pearland Barkway was the owners' and employees' realization that the Pearland area, at the time, lacked facilities to provide care for pets in an open environment as opposed to traditional kennels. Similar businesses have since opened in Pearland. Pearland Barkway is far from a traditional kennel. This business is based on the idea that animals should get plenty of playtime and socialization with other animals in large open areas.

Pearland Barkway provides playtime, naptime, and, of course, plenty of walks during doggie day care. This business also provides grooming and in-home care. A well-experienced grooming staff with prior job training as veterinarian technicians sets Pearland Barkway apart.

Founded in 2011 by Susan and Daniel McCormack, Pearland Barkway recently marked their first year in business. A celebration will be planned in the near future, so visit their website or facebook page for information on the celebration day.

Affiliated as a business partner with Pet Hub Animal Rescue, the Pearland Barkway supports Pet Hub's PETS411 program that provides a free mechanism within the community to reunite pets with their owners.
