

## Project Pearland School P.A.S.S. collects school supplies

Collection boxes are popping up all over Pearland as Project Pearland Student Supply (Pearland Student Supply) begins its second year of collecting school supplies for students in need in partnership with local Walgreens, other businesses and Pearland ISD, Project P.A.S.S. organized by Pet Hub Animal Rescue hopes to collect 300 lbs. of school supplies this year. Last year the Project collected more than 200 lbs. of school supplies for hundreds of students across Pearland. The economy is tougher this year than it was last year, so the need is even greater, Project P.A.S.S. Executive Director Tammy Dexter says. Unlike other similar collection programs, all donations will stay in Pearland. "We are glad to be part of this effort to help students get off to a good start in school," says Dexter. "We hope many of our patrons will join us in supporting this project by stopping in to donate supplies for children in need." Items in high demand include paper, pencils, pens and backpacks, according to Ginette Gomez Padilla, 7th grade English Language Arts (ELA) teacher for Pearland ISD. Donations can be made August 15-22 at any Pearland Walgreens location as well as at Beef O' Brady's at West Broadway St. or The Drink Station at 8209 Broadway St. #103.
