Whereas, Cats and dogs provide companionship for over 70 million individuals in the United States, but the population of homeless animals is reaching a crisis proportion as many people are abandoning their animals during this economic downturn; and

Whereas, The problem of overpopulation costs tax payers millions of dollars through animal control programs and adoption efforts which are critical to animal overpopulation, however, our humane societies and shelters still must euthanize approximately four million animals each year; and

Whereas, It is recognized that the management of this population of former companion animals through promotion of spay-neuter initiatives, the recognition of our many responsible pet owners, and the continued encouragement of our citizens to adopt homeless animals is the most humane approach to pet overpopulation; and

Whereas, Veterinarians, humane societies, shelters, national and local animal protection organizations, and private citizens are working together to create a public awareness campaign to advocate the spaying or neutering of our companion animals as the most cost effective method of addressing our animal overpopulation.
